

2007 Wednesday Night Series
Committee Boat Duty Roster

The week before your day of duty:

1. Arrange to have at least one other person on the boat with you. Ask this person(s) to review all the information that you will be asked to review in order to prepare.
2. Plan to have someone you know stay near a TV or computer and in touch with you via cell phone to give you updates on any questionable weather.
3. Read the information made available on the website. Got to www.outriggeryachtclub.org and follow the link on the to prepare yourself. Follow the link to Committee Boat Duty Help Guides found in the Index on the left side of the page. At minimum, read the Wednesday Night Series Committee Boat Duty Guide, the Racing Signal Flags Guide and the Suggested Race Courses Guide. Read through these documents at least a couple of times. Copies are on the Committee Boat for quick reference while you are on the water. You should also read the Wednesday Night Series Notice of Race, the Lakewide Sailing Instructions and the Race Committee Procedures Manual.
4. Keep in mind that Wednesday Night races end at 8:30PM. Those who have not finished by then are scored DNF. Also keep this in mind when planning your course...Every competitor should be given an opportunity to finish the race.
5. After the race, bring the results to Midtown Sundries to be scores and awards presented.

One the day of your duty, please arrive at the ramp dock at Peninsula Yacht Club (furthest dock to the right as you face the water) by 4:30 to go over boat operation and receive instructions.
