

5. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

5.1 Notice to competitors shall be posted on the official bulletin board located as follows:

LNKYC Located downstairs in the Clubhouse

OYC Located on the OYC website at www.Outriggeryachtclub.org, or as prescribed in the Notice of Race.

PYC Located downstairs at the clubhouse.

LNKC On the hosting club's Official Bulletin Board.

5.2 Responsibility for noting the official bulletin board rests with the contestants.

5.3 Sailing Instructions, schedule of races, and other items of interest to competitors may be changed by timely posting of changes on the bulletin board.

5.4 RC may broadcast information posted on the bulletin board to competitors on VHF Channel 71.

6. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

6.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed as follows:

LNKYC From flag mast next to the clubhouse.

OYC From the mast of the committee boat or as prescribed in the Notice of Race.

PYC From flag mast at the clubhouse.

LNKC As prescribed above for the hosting club.

6.2 Postponement Ashore: In the event of postponement ashore, the Race Committee will postpone the scheduled starts in accordance with RRS 27.3, 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled warning signal. Code Flag AP, Answering Pennant with two (2) sound signals means racing is postponed. The warning signal will be made 30 minutes after AP is lowered accompanied by one (1) sound signal.

16. SCORING

16.1 Scoring will be based on the Low Point System, per RRS Appendix A of the Racing Rules. Scoring for LNKC Series' will be as per Appendix A2 of the Racing Rules, as outlined in the Invitation to Race. For one or two-day regattas, Appendix A2 of the Racing Rules will apply except that each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races (no throwouts). One race shall constitute a regatta.

17. SAFETY

17.1 Each boat is required to notify the Race Committee when it retires and before leaving the racecourse.

17.2 Each boat shall be equipped with safety gear as required by Federal, State, Local, Class and Fleet Regulations.

17.3 RRS 40 is changed. Flag Y will not be displayed.

18. RRS 26 – STARTING RACES

Races shall be started by using the following signals. Times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

<u>Signal</u>	<u>Flag and Sound</u>	<u>Minutes before starting signal</u>
Warning	Class Flag; 1 sound	5*
Preparatory	P, I, Z, I with Z, or black flag; 1 sound	4
One-Minute	Preparatory Flag removed; 1 long sound	1
Starting	Class Flag removed; 1 sound	0

*Or as stated in the Sailing instructions

The Warning signal for each succeeding class shall be made with, or after the starting signal of the preceding class
