

- W** Weather mark set by the Committee Boat no less than 250 yards to weather of the starting line.
- D** Temporary mark which may be set by the Race Committee in Torrence Creek 250 yards W of I-77.
- O** Temporary finishing mark set in the mouth of PYC harbor (Outrigger Harbor), proper entry shall be south of Marker 2.
- T** Temporary racing mark (yellow tetrahedron) which may be set by the Race Committee when conditions prohibit having a fair race using the permanent marks.

9. REPORTING TO THE COMMITTEE BOAT

Each competing boat shall report to the Committee Boat prior to each day's race. Failure to do so shall result in no record of your start (DNS).

- 9.1 The Committee Boat will raise Numeral Flag 3 when it is prepared for check-in. Approach and cross astern of the Race Committee on a Starboard Tack with mainsail hoisted and report your sail number. The Numeral Flag 3 will be lowered one minute prior to the warning signal of the first class to start and be accompanied by one sound signal.
- 9.2 No skipper should abandon efforts to report in until they have distinctly heard their sail numbers acknowledged by the Committee Boat, Number (your sail number) Acknowledged.

10. THE START AND STARTING LINE

- 10.1 Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26. The class flag for the Spinnaker fleet will be the Numeral Flag 1 and the Spinnaker fleet will be the first start. The class flag for the Non-Spinnaker fleet will be the Numeral Flag 2 and the Non-Spinnaker fleet will be the second start. The class flag for the Cruiser fleet will be the Numeral Flag 3 and the Cruiser fleet will be the third start.
- 10.2 The Starting Line will lie between the mast flying the RC Flag on the Committee Boat, and the Starting Pin (OYC, PYC, and LNKC). The Starting Line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Boat and the Starting Pin (LNYC).

- 10.3 The location of the Starting Line will be as follows, unless designated otherwise in the Notice of Race and/or Sailing Instructions.

- 10.4 Boats whose preparatory signal has not been made shall stay clear of the starting area and of all boats whose preparatory signal has been made.

11. RECALLS

Individual Recall will be made in accordance with RRS 29.1 - Flag X with one (1) sound signal. Flag X will stay up for a maximum of two (2) minutes after the starting signal,

12. SHORTENED COURSE

- 12.1 The Race Committee may shorten the course for all fleets by displaying Flag S with two (2) sound signals and by setting a finish line between a committee boat and a rounding mark or channel marker.
- 12.2 No course shall be shortened to less than the first posted rounding mark.
- 12.3 Shortened course for Spinnaker fleet only shall be displayed by the Race Committee by Flag S over Flag S accompanied by two (2) sound signals.
- 12.4 Shortened course for Non-Spinnaker fleet only shall be displayed by the Race Committee by Flag S over Flag N, accompanied by two (2) sound signals.
- 12.5 Shortened course for the Cruiser fleet only shall be displayed by the Race Committee by Flag S over Flag C, accompanied by two (2) sound signals.
